One of the best things about living in the Sunabe area is by far for myself and my family - Coffee Casa! This neighborhood coffee shop serves the best cold coffees with decadent, REAL whipped cream in either banana mocha or caramel mocha flavors. Every time I order one, my kids and I fight over who gets the most yummy whipped cream. Coffee Casa also has quite an extensive lunch menu with weekly specials such as Chili served with tortilla chips or Naan pizza sets that include a drink (usually tea or a latte) and dessert. The pasta dishes are also quite tasty with just the right balance of flavors. I've tried the spaghetti with a meat sauce that is pretty hearty, the fettucine with shrimp cream sauce (my favorite), and a mildly spicy penne arrabiata. Of course, being a coffee shop, they boast several varieties of coffee drinks and homemade desserts. I have as yet to sample every dessert, but the lemon chiffon and cheesecake were both delicious.
