The restaurant has big windows and they overlook the Pacific Ocean. The view is magnificent. The ambiance of the restaurant is very nice and modern. The ocean view and decor are not the only selling points of this restaurant. Their food is great as well. Examples of the dishes on their menu are a curry rice, omelet, different kinds of pasta and daily special. For lunch, the average price is around 1000 yen which comes with a self-service green salad bar and a drink bar with water, tea, and coffee.
